OPERATION

TURNING ON/OFF



Press power button located on top of main body to turn light on and to cycle through

modes: High > Low > SOS > Strobe > Off

CHARGING

1) Plug the micro-USB cable into the micro-USB port of the ROVER 2) plug the other end of the cable into a USB wall charger*, USB car charger*, or any other USB charging device* (such as a computer). *Not included. *Charger output of 1A to 2A is recommended to charge the ROVER. To prevent battery damage charger output should NOT exceed 2A.

- - Power button blinks while charging then solid glow when fully charged.
- **Please recharge a stored unit every four months to maintain optimum performance of the lithium-ion battery and maximize charging levels. Damage to unmaintained battery is not covered by warranty.
