2 Camera Lenses

- The Macro lens and the Wide Angle lens come attached and should be used together.
- The Macro lens must be used separately.

NOTE: Keep 1-2 cm distance from your object to for better resolution.

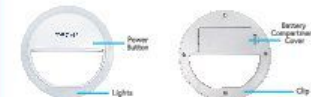


4 Selfie Clip

The selfie clip provides light to the front facing camera of your mobile device (Mobile phone, tablet, computer etc.) creating beautiful well lit selfies and videos.

To use:

1. Remove the battery compartment cover on the back of the selfie clip. Insert 2 AAA batteries (not included), secure the battery compartment cover back onto the selfie clip.
2. Apply pressure to the top of the selfie clip to open and assemble the clip onto your mobile device.
3. Press the power button on the selfie clip to turn on the light, there are 3 brightness settings to choose from. Continue pressing the power button to cycle through the lighting modes until the desired lighting is selected. You can press the power button as many times necessary to turn the light off.

- Attach phone onto mount by pulling on the tab and then releasing to hold phone in place.

6 Shutter Remote

The shutter remote can be used to remotely control your mobile device's camera shutter. The shutter remote operates via Bluetooth.

Make sure the mobile device (Mobile phone, tablet, computer etc.) you are trying to pair the shutter remote with supports Bluetooth. Specific pairing procedures may vary depending on the mobile device you are trying to pair with, for detailed information on using the Bluetooth function of your mobile device, please refer to the mobile devices user guide.

1. Slide the power switch on the shutter remote to the on position.
2. On your mobile device navigate to Settings> Bluetooth and search/scan for "Tech2 Remote Shutter" (Some mobile devices will begin searching automatically) then select it.
3. Some mobile devices may confirm if you want to connect to "Tech2 Remote Shutter" select "Yes" or "Enter" to complete the pairing process. If your mobile device prompts you to enter a password, enter the password 0000.

- 7 Once connected, launch the camera app on your mobile device. Press the shutter button to take a photo. Holding the shutter button will enter burst mode on the camera depending on if your mobile device supports/ has this feature. To use the shutter remote to capture video, launch the camera app on your mobile device and select the video mode. Press the shutter button to start video recording, press the shutter button again to end video recording.
