



SET UP AND PLAY INSTRUCTIONS **SFT UP**

Step 1. Remove all components from the carton.

Step 2. Flip the main unit Part A upside down and place on a protected surface, Locate Part B foot connectors and Part F screws. With a Philips head screw driver (not included) attach the connectors to the main unit.

Step 3. Insert and twist Part D straight steel legs to the front foot connectors. Make sure you hear the click to ensure it is locked and secure.

Step 4 Insert the Adjustable Steel Leg Part E into the foot connector closes to the handle. Make sure the leg locks in position.

Step 5. Flip the main unit onto its legs.

Step 6. Insert the Power Adaptor into the machine and then into the 120V standard power outlet. Wait for the red light to turn off to confirm the battery is charged and ready to use.

Step 7. Now you are ready to play. Find a suitable open area that is safe for your pet to play. Position the machine on a flat surface.

- What if I left the machine outdoors and the machine has some slight dew on it? Use a cloth to remove the excess moisture and wait for the unit to dry before powering on. This unit is not meant to get wet so please store inside.
- · Why won't the machine power on? Check to ensure the unit is charged and you see a green light. If no visible light try recharging. You can also try turning the power dial on.
