AFTER PLAY

- 1. ALWAYS turn your RSF Automatic Pet Launcher OFF after use. Turn the Distance Dial to off until it clicks off. Also remove the power adaptor from the input. Wait for the motor to stop.
- 2. Store your RSF Automatic Pet Launcher indoors after play in a clean and dry location.



NOTE: DO NOT LEAVE THE UNIT OUTSIDE, WATER MAY CORRODE THE INTERNAL COMPONENTS CAUSING THE RSF AUTOMATIC PET LAUNCHER TO NO LONGER FUNCTION PROPERLY.

MAINTENANCE & CLEANING

- · Your RSF Automatic Pet Launcher requires no regular maintenance.
- · If your RSF Automatic Pet Launcher needs to be cleaned, use a slightly damp cloth. DO NOT use chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- · ALWAYS turn your RSF Automatic Pet Launcher OFF prior to cleaning. DO NOT attempt to clean the launch mechanism.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- · Do I have to use only the RSF Automatic Tennis Ball or all weather ball? Our RSF tennis balls or all weather ball perform the best, however most other tennis balls that are approximately the same size and weight (e.g. official tennis balls) should launch.
- · If my dog slobbers a lot and the ball is super wet will the ball still launch? Yes, the ball will launch but the distance will be decreased. Use a dry ball or all weather ball for optimal performance.
- · How do you get the best performance from the machine? Use the included power adaptor and a fresh ball.
- · If the distance is not being met what should I do? Check the power dial? Check the height trajectory and ensure its at the highest position, and lastly use a new ball.
- · What if I left the machine outdoors and the machine has some slight dew on it? Use a cloth to remove the excess moisture and wait for the unit to dry before powering on.
- · Why won't the machine power on? Check to ensure the power adaptor is plugged in. Check to make sure the power dial is turned on and also if you are using batteries you may need to replace them.
- · What happens if I put other things into the hopper? This is very dangerous. You should only use tennis balls or all weather balls with this machine. Failure to do so may cause injury or damage to your machine.





Consider using the ball launch warning sensor by turning the switch on or off.

Make sure you select the proper power setting for play area.

Wait for the motor speed to power up then insert only one ball into the hopper at a time. Train your pet to retrieve the ball.

Readjust the position of the launcher as needed. Supervision is required. Watch to ensure your RSF Automatic Pet Launcher stays upright and is functioning properly at all times. Use DRY tennis balls or all weather balls for optimal performance.



There is an optional battery compartment which holds [8] size "D" Alkaline batteries, use small Phillips head screwdriver to open compartment. (batteries sold separately)






- GENERAL NOTES
