

# ATTACHMENT GUIDE

Hard floor brush Bathroom, uneven tile floors, rough floors, balcony

Long bristle brush Toilet, car tires, deep/hard-to-reach areas


Hook & loop pad + Scouring pad Smooth tiles, sink, bathtub

Hook & loop pad + Sponge pad Cars, windows, glass and other delicate surfaces

Hook & loop pad + Cotton flannel pad Bathtub, ceramic and other smooth surfaces, wood floors

# ASSEMBLING THE BRUSH HEAD

It is easy to change the included brush heads. Simply align the head with the body and push into place. To remove, simply grasp the brush head and pull away from the body of the device.



#### **OPERATION**

The Ultimate Cordless Power Scrubber by Sharper Image has two speeds:

- 1. Press the power button ONCE and the brush will rotate 220-230 RPM (Low speed).
- 2. Press the power button A SECOND TIME and the brush will rotate 260-270 RPM (High speed).
- 3. Press the power button for A THIRD TIME and the device will turn OFF.

## WATERPROOF USAGE



Please note the Water Depth Line when using the Ultimate Cordless Power Scrubber by Sharper Image.

The portion of the Ultimate Cordless Power Scrubber by Sharper Image **BELOW** the Angle Adjustment Button is IPX7 waterproof, and can be used in water (such as a pool or boat hull).

The portion of the Ultimate Cordless Power Scrubber by Sharper Image **ABOVE** the Angle Adjustment Button is IPX4 water resistant, and should **NOT** be submerged in water.

#### WATERPROOF RATING DETAILS

IPX7 = One of the highest waterproof ratings. Devices with this rating can withstand immersion in water up to 3 feet for 30 minutes.

IPX4 = Resistant to light splashes. Do not submerge in water.

#### AXIS OF ROTATION

The rotating shaft can be adjusted in three angles (90°, 145° and 180°) depending on the job at hand.

- 1. Press and hold the rotary buttons on both sides with one hand.
- 2. Adjust the device shaft with the other hand. Release the buttons when the shaft is in the desired position.  $_{-\,3\,-}$

## EXTENSION ROD

For high areas, this device includes an extension rod. Snap the rod into place to increase your reach [maximum length 44"].

# CHARGING THE DEVICE

- 1. Be sure to use the cable that came with this device.
- 2. The charging port is on the back of the handle.
- 3. Plug the cable into a USB port or AC outlet (USB-to-AC adapter not included)
- 4. When charging, the display will light up, indicating that it is fully charged.

- · This device is intended for household use only.
- · Do not submerge completely in water.
- · In the unlikely event of a malfunction, turn the device off and restart it.
- · Do not use this device if the cable is frayed or worn.
