INDOOR/OUTDOOR SWING GROOVER™ **Set-Up Instructions**

Please read and follow these instructions carefully before using your Swing Groover™. Failure to follow the instructions may result in damage to your product, golf club, or possibly cause injury to you or a bystander.

Assembly

Tools needed: Pocket wrench

As shown below, the Swing Groover™ is easy to assemble. Attach the balance base to the top of the rubber base. Line up the four shaft holes with the four balance base holes. Twist in 3/4" bolts, lock in the washers & nuts then tighten bolts with included pocket wrench.

Location

Find a flat area to set up your Swing Groover™. Set the base on the ground and secure firmly with included metal stakes. The area should be free of rocks or other debris, and allow enough room to swing the club freely. DO NOT FACE THE SWING GROOVER™ IN A DIRECTION WHERE THE BALL COULD INJURE SOMEONE IF IT WERE TO DETACH FROM THE CORD.
