



# Installing your Drivable 2 or 4 Passenger Enclosure

**Kit Includes:** Executive Carrying Case / Drivable 2 or 4 Passenger Enclosure / Instruction Booklet

## INSTALLATION

- 1 Throw your enclosure over the roof of the golf cart with the long panel at the back.
- 2 Let all panels hang down flat into place.
- 3 On each corner under your enclosure roof you will find two webbing straps. Run one strap around the windshield support bracket and then attach the other strap to it. Repeat on the remaining three corners.
- 4 Zip all the zippers down from the outside.
- 5 On each side, along the bottom of the cover, there are multiple "J" hooks for securing your cover to the bottom of your golf cart. Hook the straps under your cart at the front corner, back corner and in the middle by the door, then adjust the tension with the buckle on each strap.
- 6 For entry, unzip the zipper on the back of the door. To keep either door open, simply roll the door up and fasten with the straps at the top. If you want to get in and out of your car without rolling up the door just unzip the middle zipper. You will be able to enter or exit by pulling the door toward the front of the cart.
- 7 Golf clubs can be placed and retrieved from the back by unzipping the two rear zippers.
- 8 In good weather, the front panel, doors, back side panels, and back panel can be rolled up independently.
- 9 Some 4 passenger enclosures may have metal support rods to give structure to the rear of the enclosure. If included, piece poles together and slide into pocket on back flap. Pocket is located on the inside of fabric portion of back flap.

## CLEANING AND CARE

Proper care will extend the life of your golf cart enclosure. If your cover becomes dirty, it can be cleaned with lukewarm water, a mild soap and sponge. Do not use an abrasive cleaner or brush.

If the clear vinyl windows on your cover are wrinkled from storage you can smooth them out by laying the product out flat in a warm environment.

Clean clear vinyl windows with mild soap using your hands to avoid scratching the surface.

## USE AND STORAGE

A handy executive carrying case is provided. To fit it in the bag, fold your cover and roll. Never store a wet cover in the storage bag or confined area as the cover can be damaged by mildew.

## LIMITED WARRANTY

The materials and workmanship are guaranteed to be free of defects at the time of manufacture.

The product must be properly secured, maintained and utilized for the purpose for which it was intended. During installation and removal, care must be taken not to snag the cover on sharp objects. Pad all sharp corners or sharp objects on top of your golf cart.

Warranty does not cover damage from:

- High winds or Acts of Nature
- Tears from sharp objects on your golf cart
- Customer modifications or abuse
- Normal wear, weather soiling, or stains from environmental pollution
- Color fading is not covered under warranty

The warranty is not transferable and is also voided if the cover is modified in any way by the purchaser.
