#### TROUBLESHOOTING

THE DEVICE CANNOT BE USED WHILE IT IS CHARGING. BE SURE TO CHECK THE BATTERY LEVEL AND CHARGE THE DEVICE WELL IN ADVANCE OF YOUR NEXT TEE TIME.

THE ULT-G® ULTRA-LIGHT GOLF GPS WILL ONLY CONNECT TO THE SATELLITE IF YOU ARE OUTDOORS AND ABLE TO SEE THE SKY. ROOFS OR SHELTERS MAY INTERFERE WITH THE ABILITY TO CONNECT.

#### WARNING

DO NOT DISASSEMBLE, MODIFY, OR REPAIR YOUR ULT-G\* ULTRA-LIGHT GOLF GPS.
PLACING OBJECTS, SUCH AS MAGNETIC STRIPE CARDS, INCLUDING CREDIT CARDS, PHONE CARDS, PASSBOOKS, AND BOARDING PASSES, NEXT TO THE DEVICE OR CHARGER MAY CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE CHARGER OR THE ULT-G\* ULTRA-LIGHT GOLF GPS MAGNETIC FIELD.

#### CHARGING THE ULT-G<sup>®</sup>

The rechargeable Li-lon battery is charged using the clip-on charging dock and USB cable. The **ULT-G**° should be charged when the battery level has been depleted to one bar.

 Attach the clip-on charging dock to the face of the device. Be sure that both guiding pins have been well inserted and that the four battery contacts are not blocked.

- 2. Plug the USB cable into a power source. When plugged into a computer the words "USB MODE" will appear. If plugged into a wall charger the words "CHARGING" will appear with a battery icon.
- 3. Select "BATTERY" from the menu at any time to view the level of battery life. Fully charged, the battery should last for 10 hours or 2.5 rounds.







#### **LET'S GET STARTED**

Labeled in yellow, the buttons to operate the device are located at the left and right sides of the screen.



#### TURN THE ULT-G ON/OFF

#### TURN ON

 Hold the arrow □own □ button for 2 seconds to power the ULT-G° on.

#### TURN OFF

To turn the ULT-G° off hold the arrow Down 

 button for

 seconds until you see the message "POWER OFF".

#### **CHANGING THE TIME**

When the **ULT-G**° is booted up for the first time, the date will be displayed as *Monday*, *January 1st*. To change the time and date:

Press the Down 
 ¬ button to
 highlight "SETTINGS", and then
 press the Select 
 □ button located
 in between the Up 
 □ and Down 
 □ arrow buttons.

- 2. Highlight "TIME" using the arrow buttons and then select it.
- 3. Using the arrow buttons to select "DAYLIGHT" for Daylight savings time or "FORMAT" to adjust from standard/civilian to military time.
- 4. **GPS** time will show when golfing.




#### **CHANGING THE LANGUAGE**

The operating language can be changed to **English**, **French**, **German**, **Italian**, or **Spanish**. To change the language:

Press the Menu ≡ button and then press the Down ▽ button to highlight "SETTINGS", and then press the Select ▷ button located in between the Up △ and Down ▽ arrow buttons.

- 2. Highlight "LANGUAGE" using the arrow buttons and then select it.
- 3. Highlight the language of your choice using the arrow buttons and then select it.



#### BLUETOOTH

 Download the TecTecTec!°
 Golf GPS Application ("App") for Android or iOS.



2. Open the **TecTecTec!** Golf GPS App. You can create a new account; continue as a guest; or log into an existing account. You will be able to pair the device regardless of whether you've logged in or chosen to continue as a guest.

Follow the instructions provided on the screen and click on the button to "SIGN UP".

To continue as a guest, click the text "CONTINUE AS A GUEST"

If you have an existing account, enter your email and password to "LOG IN".



- 3. Ensure that your smartphone's Bluetooth is activated.
- 4. On your ULT-G°, navigate to the Menu ≡ and then use the Up △ and Down ▽ buttons to highlight "BLUETOOTH", and then press the Select ◁ button located in between the Up △ and Down ▽ arrow buttons. Be sure that "ON" is selected.



On your smartphone, in the app click on the "NEXT" button to continue.

#### **PAIR YOUR DEVICE**

Follow the steps below to connect your device.

- 1. On your smart phone, make sure your Bluetooth is set to "On". You will find Bluetooth under "Settings".
- On your TecTecTec device, go to
  "Settings" menu and select Bluetooth.

  Make sure that your Bluetooth is set to "On".

5. The first time you attempt to pair with your ULT-G°, the TecTecTec!°
Golf GPS App will ask: "Allow
TecTecTec Golf GPS to access this device's location?" Allow/Deny.
Select "Allow."

WARNING: THIS WILL ONLY BE ASKED THE FIRST TIME YOU ATTEMPT TO PAIR WITH YOUR ULT-G°. IF YOU SELECT DENY YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PAIR THE ULT-G° IN THE FUTURE. IF YOU SELECT DENY, YOU WILL NEED TO UNINSTALL THE APPLICATION ENTIRELY AND REINSTALL IT.

- 6. After the TecTecTec ! Golf GPS App has found the ULT-G, a Bluetooth pairing request will appear on your smartphone "TecTecTec sEnter PIN to pair the device."
- 7. Enter the Bluetooth 6-digit passcode provided on the ULT-G<sup>®</sup> display and select "Pair." (The passcode should be a random six-digit number).



11. When finished, the screen will show "You have successfully paired your device".

Keep your ULT-G\* and phone near each other while pairing until it is complete.

- 12. The **ULT-G**° will show "Bluetooth Connected".
- 13. Once successfully connected, the updated "Syncing Data" will begin automatically.
- 14. When finished, the screen will show "Syncing Completed".

#### **UPDATING A GOLF COURSE**

- After you pair your Bluetooth device, the TecTecTec! Galf GPS App will automatically direct you to update golf courses nearest you. You can also access the update feature using the menu on the upper right-hand side if you have previously paired your device.
- 2. Select a course to update. Courses will appear based on proximity.

You can search the database of courses by using the search at the top of the "Update Golf Course" page.

Select the Down arrow to begin the course update. The TecTecTec!\* Golf GPS APP will display a clock indicating "Updating Golf Course".

#### **GOLFING WITH THE ULT-G**<sup>®</sup>

When you have arrived at the golf course you can connect the device to a satellite and select the course that you will play.

 Outdoors, near the course you plan to play, press the SAT button once. The screen will show a satellite icon and the word "SEARCHING". Then a list of nearby courses will appear.

- 2. Select the course of your choice by pressing the Down 

  button until it is highlighted, and then pressing the Select 

  button located in between the Up 

  arrow buttons.
- Once a course is selected, the Front, Center, and Back of the Green distances for Hole 1 will be visable below the top bar displaying the hole, time, and par.











#### ROUND INFO

Press the Menu ≡ button to view the "PLAY MENU" options (Battery, New Course, or Exit Game). Press Menu ≡ again to return to your game.



Pressing the **Select** ▷ button will toggle between one or two hazard screens and the **FCB** (**Front**, **Center**, **Back**) pages. (**Hazard Glossary** on the back of manual).

#### MANUAL HOLE ADVANCE

Press **Up**△ to manually advance to the next hole, or press **Down** ∇ to manually advance to the previous hole. The **ULT-G**° will automatically advance the hole information as you move across a course. The manual advance is useful for shotgun starts.



#### TRACK SHOT DISTANCE

Use shot tracking to find the distance of your shot by measuring the distance between two points.

**Point A** will be where you've taken your shot. **Point B** will be where the ball has landed.

- After you've activated the GPS connection for your location, press the SAT button to set Point A.
- As you walk to Point B, the ULT-G° will display the distance between Point A and Point B.
