

## GAME CONTENTS

- 8 eggs and 8 ducks (2 sets of 4 colors – Orange, Blue, Green, Yellow), 2 nests and 21 game cards.

## GAME OBJECTIVE

Be the first player to arrange the ducks and eggs in the nest as illustrated on the game card. The first player to match the order on the game card wins the card. The first player to win 5 cards, wins the game.

## GAME SET UP

Each player gets one nest, one set of eggs and one set of ducks (one of each color).

The youngest player starts, shuffles the deck and flips over the top card. Once the top card is flipped over, the players race to set up their nest to match the game card that was flipped over.

When a player completes arranging their nest, they must say, "Duck, Duck, Goose." The first player who says, "Duck, Duck, Goose" takes the card (only after checking to make sure the set up matches the game card). The winner flips over a new card from the main pile and starts the next round of play.

## HOW TO WIN

The first player to collect 5 game cards wins the game!

Top of the egg orange.  
Bottom of the egg  
yellow. No duck inside.



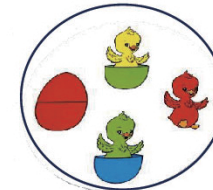
Green duck sitting inside
