5. Do not use this product on your knees for more than 30 minutes without taking at least a 5-minute break.
6. Do not use this device near water.
7. Clean only with a soft cloth.
8. Does not block any ventilation openings. Install according to instructions.
9. To prevent overheating, do not leave the device plugged in or switched on in an unventilated housing, such as a bag.
10. Do not install this unit near heat sources such as baseboard heaters, stoves or other appliances (including amplifiers).
11. Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized or grounding-type plug. A polarized plug has two prongs, one of which is wider than the other. A grounding-type plug has two flat prongs and a third round prong for grounding. The wider pin and the third pin are important safety features designed to protect you. If you are unable to insert the plug fully into the wall socket, ask an adult to contact an electrician to replace the obsolete wall socket.

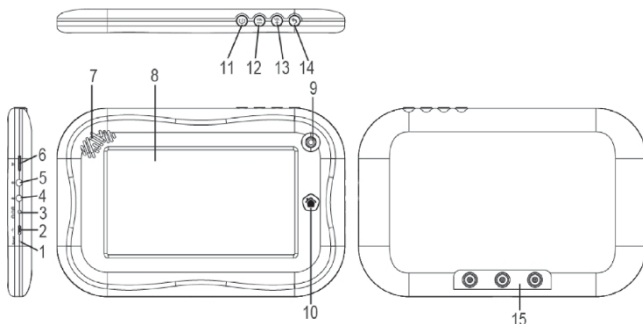

Switching the tablet on and off

1. To switch on your Lexibook® tablet, press and hold the "On/Off" button (11) on the top of the device for 3 seconds.
2. Waits for the Android operating system to start up™.
3. After a few seconds of waiting, the home screen appears.
4. To switch off your Lexibook® tablet, close all running applications and press the "On/Off" button (11) for 3 seconds.
5. Click on "OK".



Note: The device locks automatically after a few minutes of inactivity. To unlock it, press the "On/Off" button (11). A closed padlock surrounded by a circle comes to life on the screen. Slide it to the right, over the open padlock that appears, to access the home screen.

Note: You can briefly press the "On/Off" button to put your tablet to sleep.

How to set up Lexibook® parental controls

When using the tablet for the first time, we recommend that you create a password to restrict access to advanced settings (such as Wi-Fi, sound and display). **By default, there is no password.**

1. To create a password, select the ladybug icon at the top right of the screen.





2. Leave the **"Old Password"** box empty. Using the keyboard, enter a password in the **"New Password"** box. Confirm the password, then click on **"OK"**.

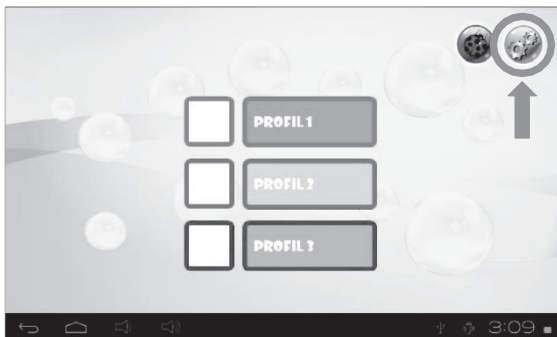


3. To change a password, enter the old password in the **"Old Password"** box. Click on **"Old Password"**. Then enter a new password in the **"New Password"** box, confirm it and click **"OK"**.





4. To access the tablet's advanced settings, select the icon
Press "**Settings**" on the top right-hand side of the screen. Enter the password, then press "**OK**".

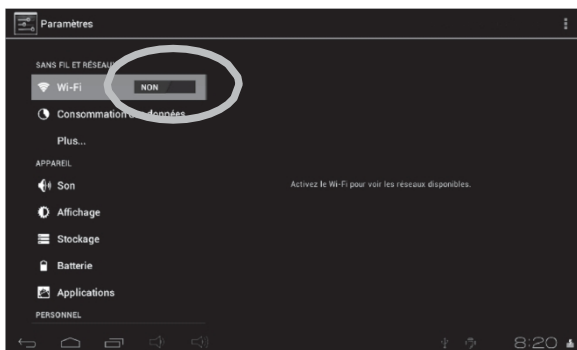


Activate the tablet's Wi-Fi function

1. From the Home screen, press the "**Settings**" touch button in the top right-hand corner.



2. Press the Wi-Fi "No" switch.





3. Wait for Wi-Fi to turn on. This may take 5 to 10 seconds.



4. The list of Wi-Fi networks appears on the right-hand side of the screen. Now select the Wi-Fi network you wish to connect to. The network name depends on the Wi-Fi modem or router you have. If you're not sure, check the relevant instruction manuals or contact your network provider.

Notes : The network list updates automatically every few seconds.

The ONDE symbol  to the right of each network indicates the strength of the Wi-Fi signal (more white bars indicate better reception).

The padlock symbol  to the right of each network indicates whether or not it is a protected Wi-Fi network.



5. Enter the Wi-Fi network password. The password depends on the Wi-Fi modem or router. If you are unsure, check the relevant instruction manuals or contact your network provider.



6. Press the **"Connect"** button to connect to the Wi-Fi network. This may take between 5 and 20 seconds. If the connection does not work, make sure the password is correct and that you are within range of the Wi-Fi network.



7. Once connected, the message **"Connected"** appears below the Wi-Fi network activated.

Connecting headphones

A headphone socket is located on the right-hand side of the unit (5). This socket is suitable for all headphones/earphones fitted with a 3.5mm jack plug. Use of headphones/earphones deactivates the loudspeaker.

CAUTION: Prolonged exposure to high sound volumes, particularly when wearing headphones or earphones, can lead to temporary or permanent hearing loss. For this reason, turn down the volume before plugging in headphones or earphones.

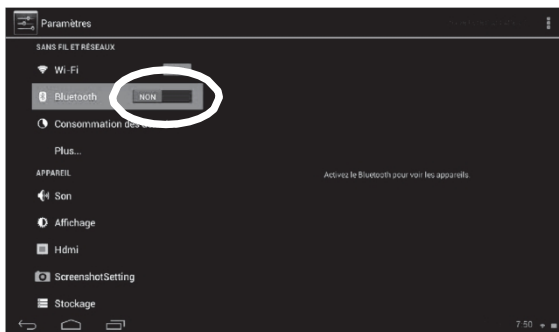

1. On the home page, select the **"Settings"** icon in the top right-hand corner, then enter the password and press **"OK"**.



2. Press the Bluetooth **"No"** switch®.

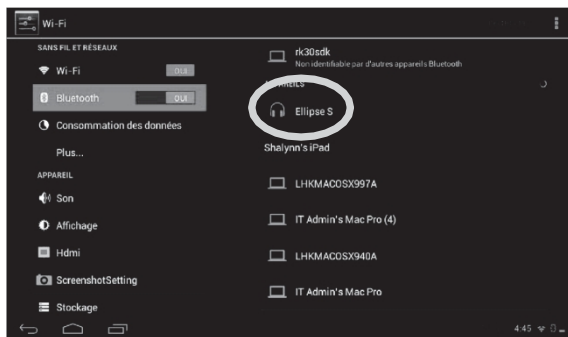


3. Wait for the Bluetooth® to light up. This may take 5 to 10 seconds.

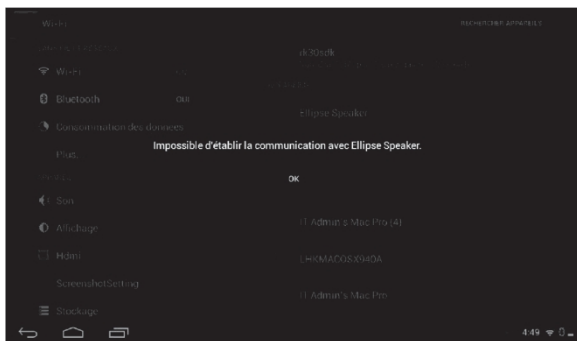


4. Switch on the Bluetooth device® . Make sure you have activated Bluetooth search mode® . For further information on device settings, please refer to your Bluetooth device's user manual® .

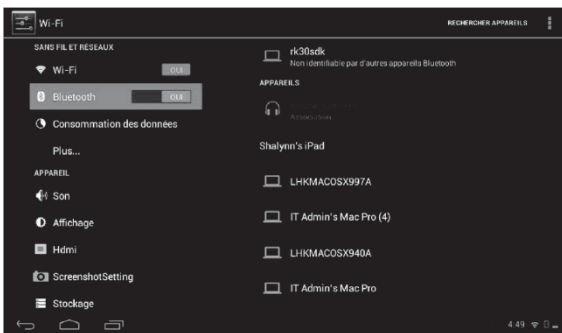
5. Once Bluetooth® is activated, the list of Bluetooth devices® appears on the right-hand side of the screen. Select the desired Bluetooth device® . This may take between 5 and 20 seconds.



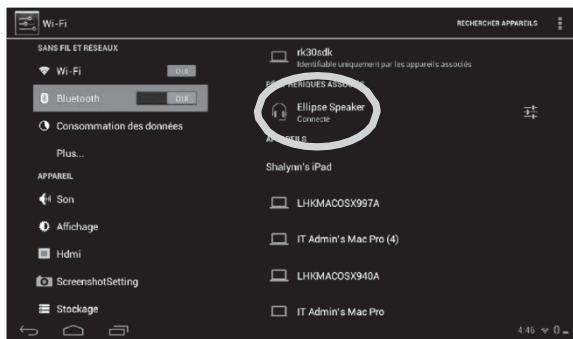
6. If the association with the Bluetooth device® does not work, a message indicating a communication problem appears on the screen. Make sure you have switched on the Bluetooth device® and that it is in search mode.



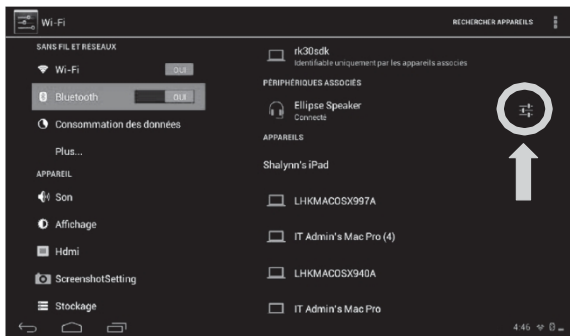
7. The tablet first associates with the Bluetooth device®, then automatically connects with it.



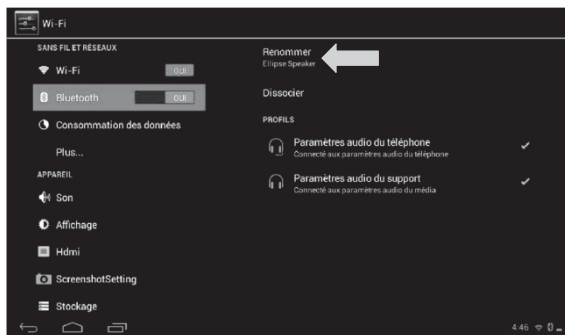
8. Once the Bluetooth device® is connected, the message "**Connected**" appears in the list of Bluetooth devices® under "**Associated devices**". To disconnect the Bluetooth device® from the tablet (while remaining associated), press the Bluetooth device name®.



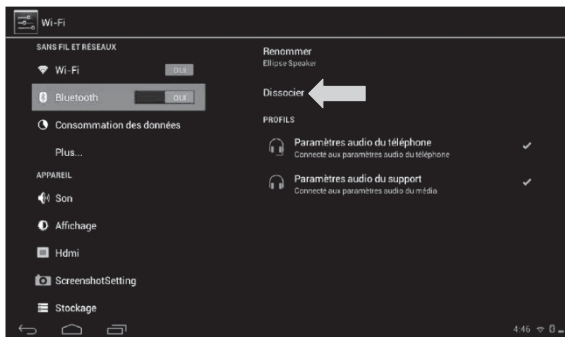
9. To modify the Bluetooth® settings of the device in question, press the "**Settings**" icon on the right.



10. Press the **"Rename"** option to change the name of the Bluetooth device®.



11. Press the **"Dissociate"** button to disconnect and dissociate the® Bluetooth device from the tablet. To reconnect it to the tablet, the device must be associated with the tablet once again.



12. The **"Profiles"** options display additional settings for the Bluetooth device® (if available).

Using a memory card

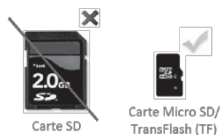
To store additional files or to have more space on your tablet, you can purchase a micro SD / TransFlash memory card (not included), then insert it into your tablet. You can also delete files included in your tablet, such as videos, songs and e-books.

Please note: once you've deleted the files on your tablet, you won't be able to recover them.

Please make a backup copy before deleting them.

• Compatible memory cards

The device is compatible with micro SD / TransFlash (TF) memory cards of up to 32GB capacity.



• Inserting a memory card

1. Insert a micro SD / TransFlash (TF) memory card into the device's built-in card reader (right-hand side), observing the direction of insertion (metal card connectors facing upwards).
2. Push the card into the card reader until it locks and you hear a "click".

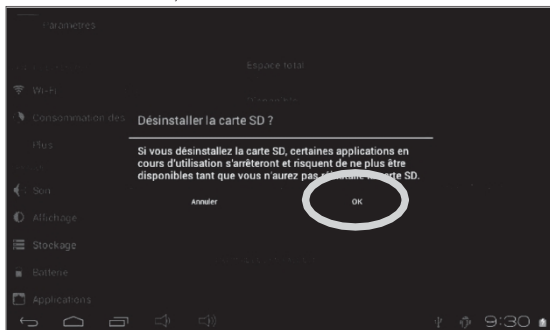
- Remove memory card

Note: BEFORE removing the memory card from the player, you must deactivate it.

1. In the Settings menu, select "Storage" and then click on "Uninstall SD card".



2. Press "OK" to confirm, then wait for deactivation.



3. You can now remove the card. Press and release the card to remove it from the reader.
4. Then grasp the card and gently remove it from the tablet's card reader.

Notes : *Never remove the memory card without first deactivating it.
Never remove the memory card while the device is transferring or reading data. You risk losing data and/or damaging the memory card.*

• Format memory card

1. In the Settings menu, select "Storage" and then click on "Delete SD card".



2. Confirm twice by clicking on the "Delete SD card" button and "Erase everything".



Note: The "Erase SD card" function **permanently** deletes all the contents of the SD card inserted in the tablet.



Touch navigation

The touch screen makes navigation fast and easy. Move your finger across the surface of the touchscreen to select different menus or applications and navigate your Lexibook® tablet.

- To select or launch a menu or application, press the touchscreen once with your finger.
- To move an element, hold your finger on the element and drag it to the desired location.

• Navigation with Explorer

When you use Explorer to browse your files, you go directly to the selected file. To scroll through your image files and browse your photos, use the "Gallery" application, accessible from the applications menu.

• Gallery navigation

Using the Gallery to browse your images, you can scroll through your image files. Images imported to your Lexibook® tablet via USB or micro SD / TransFlash (TF) card are automatically added to the Gallery.

• Touchscreen precautions :

The following precautions should be taken when using the touchscreen:

- Ensure that the touchscreen does not come into contact with dirt, liquids or grease.
- Do not touch the touchscreen with dirty hands or sharp objects.
- Do not place heavy objects on the touchscreen.
- In some cases, the touchpad may become inoperative. In this case, restart the device or reset the system.

Note: *To further protect the touchscreen, the device is supplied with a protective film. Already installed on the screen, this protective film must be removed the first time it is used.*



Rotate screen

Your tablet is equipped with a built-in motion sensor. Pages can be displayed in portrait (vertical) or landscape (horizontal) mode.

To change the orientation of the page displayed on the screen, simply rotate your tablet. This automatically adjusts the size and orientation of the page you're viewing. Please note: some applications do not have this function.

Notes : For page rotation to be automatic when you rotate your tablet, the "Auto screen rotation" option ("Settings / Display" menu) must be activated.

Use the virtual keyboard

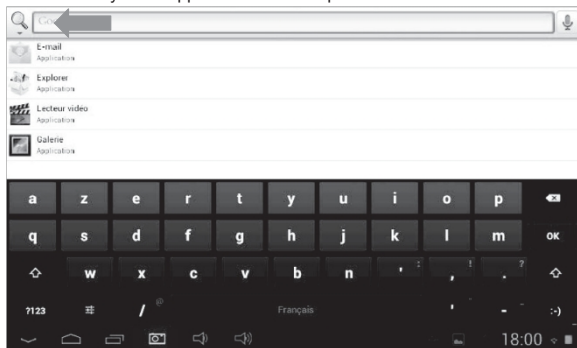
Your tablet is equipped with a virtual keyboard that lets you type text, enter e-mail addresses or perform Internet searches.

• Bring up the keyboard


1. Press the text entry field.

Note: The "text entry field" is where you type your text, such as a search bar.

2. The virtual keyboard appears below the input field.



3. Type your text using the virtual keyboard.
4. Press the "OK" key on the keyboard to finish and launch the search.

5. Press the HIDE KEYBOARD touch button  or outside the keyboard to hide the keyboard.

Notes :

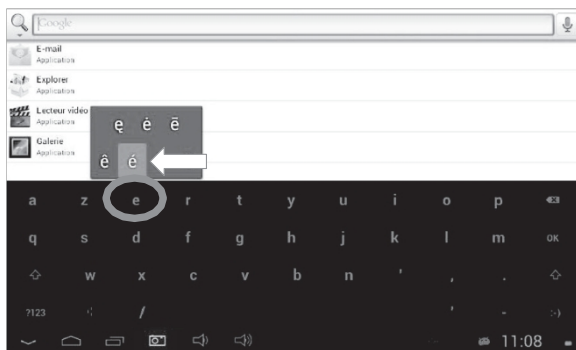
To make text entry easier, you can connect a Lexibook® keyboard to your tablet.
Keyboard keys may vary according to the application used.

• **Typing special characters**

Some special characters, such as those with accents (à, è, é, ù...), do not appear on the keyboard. To display these characters :

1. Hold down the key closest to the character you wish to type.

Example: Hold down the "e" key for the "é" character.



2. A menu of available special characters appears.
3. Slide your finger over the character you wish to type, then release the key.

• **Entering numbers**

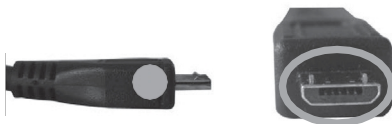
To type numbers, you can use the  key to bring up the numeric keypad.



Insert micro USB plug

WARNING: Ask your parents or an adult for help before plugging the micro USB side of the cable into your tablet. Don't install it on your own. The micro USB plug is fragile, so don't force it in - you could break it.

Insert the micro USB plug into the micro USB port, observing the direction of insertion (pins/longer side up) as shown in the photos below.



Notice to parents:

Please ensure that your child inserts the plug on the correct side.

Charging the battery

IMPORTANT: The battery must be charged for at least 8 to 12 hours before first use.

Your tablet is equipped with an internal rechargeable battery. You can recharge the battery using the AC adapter (supplied).

• Charging via AC adapter

1. Connect the plug of the AC adapter (supplied) to the power input of your Lexibook® tablet, and the other end of the AC adapter to an electrical outlet.

Note: You can use the device while it's charging. It may take longer to fully charge the battery.

2. The battery charge icon remains lit during charging, indicating charging progress.
3. When the battery is fully charged, you can disconnect the AC adapter from the device and then from the wall socket.

Note: The battery can be recharged while the device is on, in standby or off.



Using the battery

Notes :

- Use only the AC adapter supplied with the unit. Do not use other power supplies or electrical devices.
- Whenever possible, keep the AC adapter connected to the device and to a power outlet to recharge the battery.
- Always wait at least 5 seconds after switching off the unit before restarting it. Switching the unit off and on again immediately can damage electrical circuits.
- The electrical outlet to which the unit is connected must be installed close to the equipment and must always be easily accessible.

Battery life depends largely on how you use it. This may affect its performance.

The lithium battery must only be used with this device. Do not disassemble the battery. Do not dispose of the battery in fire or water. To avoid the risk of fire, burns or damage to the battery, ensure that no metal objects come into contact with the battery terminals. Handle damaged or leaking batteries with great care. In the event of contact with electrolyte, wash with soap and water. In case of eye contact, rinse with water for 15 minutes and seek medical advice. Do not charge the battery if the ambient temperature exceeds 45° C. To dispose of the battery, contact your local dealer and ask for information about local regulations on battery disposal or recycling. To recharge the battery, use only the adapter supplied.

WARNING: Strong electromagnetic interference or electrostatic discharge may cause malfunction or data loss. If the unit does not operate correctly, reset the unit or unplug the AC adapter from the wall socket, then plug it back in.





2. The home screen of the Lexibook® tablet


The taskbar


The taskbar is located at the bottom of the screen. It includes :



- **Status icons:** Icons that provide information (battery charge level, Wi-Fi connection status, etc.).
- **Tactile keys:** keys for direct access to certain menus or functions on the tablet.

• Home screen touch buttons


Back" touch button  to return to the previous screen.

Exit" touch button  to exit the current application and return to the home screen.

Recent" touch button  for quick access to recently used applications.

Options" touch button  to access options for the current application (if available).

Volume -" touch button  to lower the volume of the unit.

Volume +" touch button  to increase the volume of the device.

Settings" touch button  to access device settings.



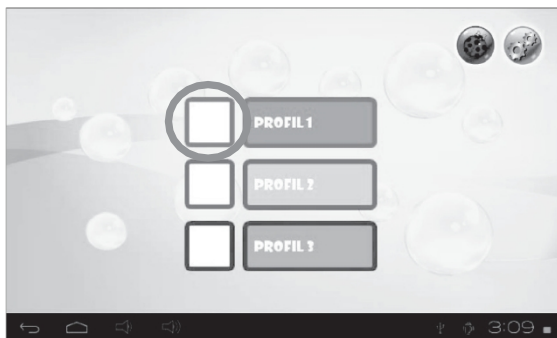

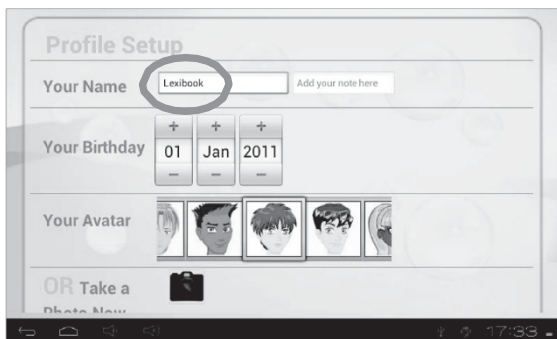

2. Click on the "Your Name" input field, then type a name.



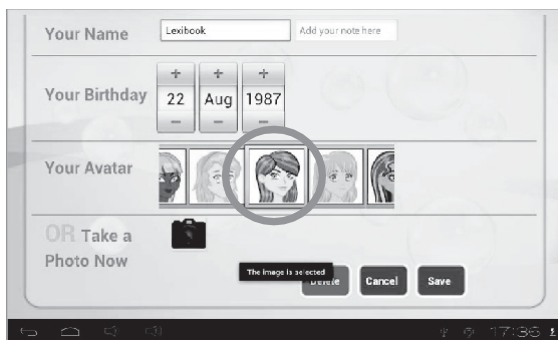
3. You can add a personal message in the box on the right.
