### OTHER MAINTENANCE TIPS

- Put your LapLok in its Protective Bag when not in use.
- Do not expose your LapLok to water or extreme temperatures.
- Do not leave your LapLok unattended for extended periods of time.
   Although the LapLok is extremely secure, all anti-theft devices can eventually be compromised with enough time.
- Care for your LapLok like you would other valuable electronics. It is good to periodically clean the rubber pads and/or do not use LapLok on extremely dirty surfaces
- When deciding on your Lock/Unlock Code, choose a 3-5 digit number that is easy for you to remember and store it somewhere you won't forget, such as your laptop, phone and/or the inside of the lever.
- Change your Lock/Unlock Code every so often for better security hygiene.

#### SAFETY PRECAUTIONS


- Before attaching LapLok, ensure that the table surface is suitable for a laptop. We do not recommend using LapLok on table linens as the grip is not sufficient.
- Position LapLok on the table edge, ensuring it avoids walkway obstruction or tripping hazards.
- Avoid injury by always making sure your fingers are not in the way when attaching your LapLok to a table.
- Do not ingest Primer and/or Adhesive or let it contact your skin during use. In case of any accident, immediately rinse the affected area with plenty of soap & water. If skin irritation, redness, or any other adverse reaction occurs, seek medical advice.
- Keep Primer and Adhesive away from open flames. These
  materials are flammable and should be used and stored in a
  well-ventilated area, away from any sources of ignition. If Primer is
  inhaled accidentally, move to an area with fresh air and ensure
  proper ventilation. If respiratory discomfort or difficulty persists,
  seek medical attention promptly.
- The included Primer or Adhesive should be just enough to use for the Parking Tab, Mounting Arm, and laptop Rubber Feet. Discard any remaining primer with caution. Keep Primer or Adhesive away from children & pets.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions for proper LapLok use.

**NOTE: Primer** may contain chemicals or substances that have properties that can penetrate the skin and cause skin irritation, allergic reactions, respiratory discomfort, or other adverse effects.

# **HOW TO USE YOUR LAPLOK**

# STEP 1: Register Your Lock/Unlock Code

- Go to https://reset.LapLok.com/ or scan the QR code to bring you to the registration page.
- Input your name, e-mail address, phone number, and 5-Digit Device Serial Number found at the bottom of your LapLok.
- 3. A 4-Digit Verification Code will be sent to the phone number and e-mail you entered.
- Enter the 4-Digit Verification Code into the LapLok website's registration page.
- 5. Choose and enter a **3-5 Digit Lock/Unlock Code** you would like to use with your **LapLok** per instructions on Step 4.
- 6. Write your 3-5 Digit Lock/Unlock Code on the inside of the lever.

**NOTE:** Save your **Lock/Unlock Code** somewhere safe. See "Other Maintenance Tips" for details.





# STEP 2: Battery Activation

Batteries are already installed in the LapLok you received.

- 1. Pull back the **Locking Pins** to unlock and raise the **Top**
- Underneath the Top, locate and activate the Switch, turning it to the 'ON' position.
- Close the LapLok by pulling back the Locking Pins, then release them into the Bolt Catch.
- To test if the Batteries are working, press the Lock Button once.
   When you see the RED LED blink twice, this indicates that battery is now activated.

**NOTE:** Under normal use conditions, **Batteries** should last about 5 years. If you need to replace them in the future, kindly refer to the 'Replacing the Batteries' section.





# STEP 3: Attach the Mounting Plate, Arm, Parking Tab, and laptop Rubber Feet

1. Decide where on the bottom of your laptop you would like to attach the Mounting Plate so it would be easy to rotate the 8" Mounting Arm out to attach it to your LapLok. The entire Mounting Plate and Arm should lie flat on the bottom of the laptop and should not be on top of any bumps, ridges, vents, or compartments. It should not be placed outside the edge of the laptop. If you aren't sure about the location, try taping it on as a test first.

**Tip:** For a right-handed person, it is recommended that you place it on the lower left side on the bottom of the laptop, so it is easily accessible from the side.

- Use the included Alcohol Wipe to clean the location where you would like to place the Mounting Plate.
- Squeeze the Primer Ampule tube on the black circle that say 'CRUSH' until the glass on the inside breaks and use an applicator to cover the area for Mounting Plate installation. Wait 30 seconds for it to dry.

Warning: Do not touch Primer with your skin. Do not ingest it. See "Safety Precautions" for details. You will also use the Alcohol Wipe and Primer for the Parking Tab.

4. Peel the paper backing off the **Mounting Plate** then stick onto the primed location, pressing down firmly for 30 seconds. Then wait 24 hours for the adhesive to dry. A complete cure takes 3 days.

**NOTE:** You can use your laptop during the curing period, but do not apply force on the **Mounting Arm** until fully dry.

**Warning:** The adhesive is permanent, so try to place it in the correct location the first time.

- 5. Determine where the Parking Tab will hold the end of 8" Mounting Arm, clean the area with an Alcohol Wipe, use the Primer and let it dry, remove paper tape, and glue Parking Tab to the laptop to prevent it from rotating when not in use. Press down on it firmly.
- 6. To install the provided Rubber Feet, clean the 4 corners of the laptop with the included Alcohol Wipe then apply the Primer to the area. Remove the paper backing of the sticker from the Rubber Feet, apply small amount of the included Adhesive, and press down firmly on the primed location for 30 seconds.

**NOTE:** This step is optional but adding the **Rubber Feet** will prevent laptop wobble.

 During the drying period of the attached components, we recommend to consider affixing the LapLok Warning Sticker as a theft deterrent warning to the lower right or left-hand corner of your laptop.





# STEP 4: Initial Lock/Unlock Code Setting

The default Lock/Unlock Code is preset to 1-1-1

- To change the default Lock/Unlock Code to your newly registered LapLok, press the Lock Button then press 1-1-1. When the Green LED blinks 5 times, this indicates that the LapLok is unlocked.
- Press and hold the Lock Button for 3 seconds. When you see that the Green LED blink twice, this indicates that the Lock/Unlock Code can be changed.
- Within 10 seconds, enter your new registered Lock/Unlock Code, then press the Lock Button.
- 4. Green LED blinks 3 times for successful Lock/Unlock code change.

NOTE: Red LED will blink 5 times indicating your LapLok is locked.

Additionally, the user has 10 seconds to enter their Lock/Unlock Code.

If the Lock/Unlock Code is not entered in that time frame or is incorrect,
Red & Green LEDs will blink alternately indicating the error.





# STEP 5: Lock Your LapLok to a Table

LapLok works on tables up to 2" thick

- Press the Release Lever and move the Lower Arm downward on the Upright until there is enough room between the Upper and Lower Pads to slide it over the edge of the table.
- 2. Pull back the Locking Pins to unlock and raise the Top.
- 3. Slide your LapLok over the edge of the table.
- 4. Slide the Mounting Arm into the mouth of the Upper Pad.
- Move the Lower Arm upwards on the Upright until the Lower Pad is tight against the bottom of the table and the Upright is firmly against the edge of the table.

**NOTE:** This step is critical to your **LapLok** being effective in preventing theft.

- Close the LapLok while pulling back the Locking Pins, then release the Locking Pins into the Bolt Catch.
- Arm your LapLok by pressing the Lock Button and enter your Lock/Unlock Code and the Red LED will blink indicating it is armed.

**NOTE:** Once **LapLok** has been secured to the table, you can use the provided **Carabiner** to fasten your bags onto the hole located at the end of the **Upright**.





# STEP 6: Unlock Your LapLok from the Table

 To unlock your LapLok, press the Lock Button, enter your Lock/ Unlock Code and the Green LED will blink showing it is unlocked.

**NOTE:** If the user enters the **Lock/Unlock code** incorrectly, **Red & Green LEDs** will blink alternately indicating the error. After 20 failed unlock attempts, the alarm will sound for 30 seconds.

- Pull back the Locking Pin and lift the Top.
- 3. Press the Release Lever and pull the Lower Arm down.
- Pull the Mounting Arm out of the mouth of the Upper Pad. Your laptop and LapLok are now free from the table.

## **HOW TO ADJUST THE SETTINGS**





## ADJUSTING THE ALARM VOLUME

A key **LapLok** feature is to detect movement and sound the alarm to deter theft when someone tries to move it. Setting the alarm is an optional setting.

- Press the Lock Button then press and hold the (1) Button for 3 seconds. When you see the Green LED blink twice, this indicates that you can now adjust the alarm volume.
- Within 10 seconds, press both (1/2) Buttons for high, both (3/4) Buttons for medium, both (5/6) Buttons for low, or both (7/8) Buttons for no sound.
- 3. Green LED will blink twice when successfully changed.

**NOTE:** If **LapLok** removal is attempted while locked, a 30-second alarm will be triggered & both LEDs will blink. Entering your **Lock/Unlock Code** will turn off the alarm and unlock your **LapLok**.





# CHANGING THE LOCK/UNLOCK CODE

- First, ensure your LapLok is unarmed, as the Lock/Unlock Code can only be changed when unarmed.
- Press and hold the Lock Button. When you see the Green LED blink twice, this indicates that the Lock/Unlock Code can be changed.
- Within 10 seconds, enter your new Lock/Unlock Code, then press the Lock Button.
- Green LED will blink 3 times for successful Lock/Unlock Code change.
   If the change is unsuccessful, the Red LED will blink 3 times.
- 5. Register your new Lock/Unlock Code at https://reset.techlok.com/.

**NOTE:** Make sure to save your new **Lock/Unlock Code**. See "Other Maintenance Tips" for details.





## FORGOTTEN LAPLOK'S LOCK/UNLOCK CODE

- Go to https://reset.LapLok.com/ or scan the QR code in Step 1 to get to the registration page.
- 2. Log in to your LapLok profile.

NOTE: Unregistered users must first register to log in to their profile.

3. After logging in, you will receive a unique device-specific code to your registered e-mail address or phone number.

**NOTE:** For unregistered users, there will be a 15-minute delay between sending and receiving the device-specific code to reduce the chance of fraud.

- On your LapLok, enter the unique device-specific code you just received.
- 5. If the unique device-specific code you entered into your LapLok matches the code stored at the factory, your LapLok's Lock/Unlock Code will reset to 1-1-1. When you see the Green LED blink 3 times, that means a successful Lock/Unlock Code reset.

**NOTE:** When the **LapLok** is locked, entering unique device-specific code also unlocks the device.

You can now create a new Lock/Unlock Code using the instructions in the "Changing the Lock/Unlock Code" section.

## TROUBLESHOOTING & CARE OF YOUR LAPLOK





#### REMOVING THE MOUNTING PLATE AND ARM

- To remove the Mounting Plate and Arm, use a butter knife, single-edge razor blade, or similar tool as a lever to pry them off. This design is intended to prevent theft.
- 2. Do the same to remove the Parking Tab.





#### REPLACING THE BATTERIES

**LapLok** uses two CR 2032 **Batteries** that should last about five years in normal use conditions. We estimate normal usage to be three hours per week with the siren sounding 2 times a year. The usage of **LapLok** will determine the longevity of the **Battery** life.

When your **LapLok** needs new **Batteries**, the **Red LED** will blink 5 times. The **Batteries** will last about two weeks before they become too weak to arm your **LapLok**.

- To replace the Batteries, unscrew the four Screws on the top, lift the Top, and unscrew the Screw on the bottom near the Switch at the bottom.
- 2. Open the **Top** and carefully remove the old **Batteries** and put in new
- 3. Put the Top back to the LapLok and re-insert all the Screws.
- 4. To test if the batteries are working, reactivate your LapLok by activating the Switch on then press the Lock Button once. The Red LED will blink twice if the battery replacement was succesful.
- If they are not, ensure that the new Batteries were correctly inserted.
