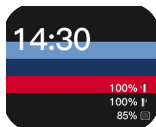


Powering on/off

Turning on the display

Press the Screen On/Off button once to turn on the display. The Coby Logo will appear. Select the language, then tap the icon < > to choose your desired wallpaper. Tap on the selected wallpaper to confirm. It will then take you to the home screen.

Home screen

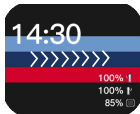


Touch Operation

- Swipe left and right on the display screen to toggle the app list.
- On the App screen, swipe up and down to select the items.
- Tap the icon on the screen to select the item.

Waking/Unlocking the display screen

If there is no operation for more than 30 seconds on the display screen, it will turn off and lock automatically. To wake the display screen, press the Screen On/Off button once or tap on the screen. Then, swipe right to unlock it.


Turning off the display

Swipe left or right on the display screen to select the 'Settings' app. Then, swipe up and down to select 'Shutdown' to turn off the display.

Turning on the earbuds

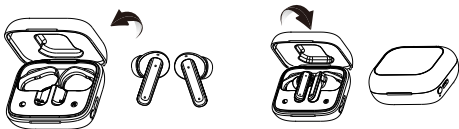
Your CETW645 earbuds will power on automatically when taken out of the Touchscreen case. You can also power them on manually by pressing and holding the Touch Sensor on both earbuds for 7 seconds.

Turning off the earbuds

Your CETW645 earbuds will power off automatically when placed back into the Touchscreen case .

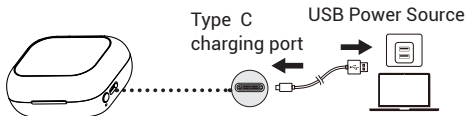


To power them off manually, press and hold the **Touch Sensor** on a single earbud for 5 seconds.



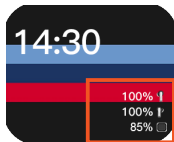

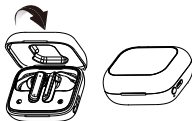
Charging your earbuds

When your earbuds' battery runs low, the earbud status indicators will slowly flash white, and a notification tone will play. Open the Touchscreen case's lid, then place the earbuds into the Touchscreen case and close the lid to start recharging.

Pairing

1. True Wireless stereo connection

When the earbuds are turned on, they will automatically enter True Wireless stereo pairing mode.








2. Connect the Earbuds & Touchscreen Case to your device

After a successful True Wireless stereo connection, your CETW645 will automatically enter Bluetooth pairing mode to connect to your device.

Turn on Bluetooth in your device's settings and search for "CETW645", then tap "CETW645" to connect.

Controls

1. Music mode

| Volume down | Quickly press the Touch Sensor three times on the left earbud. |
| Transparent mode/ANC mode | The default mode is Transparent mode. Press and hold the Touch Sensor for 2 seconds on the left earbud, to toggle among Transparent mode, ANC On mode, and ANC Off mode (Normal mode). |

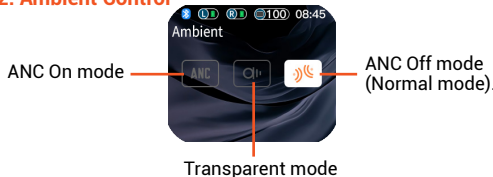
The CETW645 earbuds features with a display screen built-in the case for touch controls, allowing you to get more controls for the earbuds (Note: Make sure the CETW645 is connected to your phone.).

- Swipe left and right on the display screen to toggle the app list.
- On the App screen, swipe up and down to select the items.
- Tap the icon on the screen to select the item.
- Swipe right to return to previous screen.

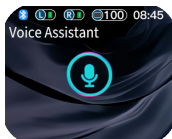

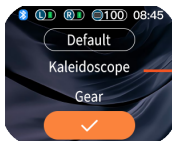



5. Voice Assistant

Make sure the CETW645 is connected to your phone. From the App list, select and open the voice assistant App, tap once on the icon  to activate the voice assistant, then you speak to the voice assistant in the Touchscreen case by a simple voice command. For example, "how is the weather in New York today?", "what is a rainbow?", and so on. After a few seconds of thinking, the voice assistant will respond to you with its Voice information.




6. Menu display style



Tap to customize the menu display style, tap  to confirm.

7. Bluetooth Camera

The Camera app in the watch allows you to remotely take pictures through your phone's camera.

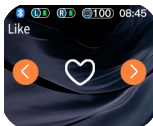
1. Open the Camera app in your phone.
2. Open the Camera Control app, and tap on the icon  to start taking photos from your phone remotely. You can view the photos on your phone.

Note: To use the Bluetooth camera, ensure that the CETW645 has been successfully paired with your phone. Also, make sure the earbuds are not in music playback mode. Keep your phone on the camera app screen, then tap to take photos.

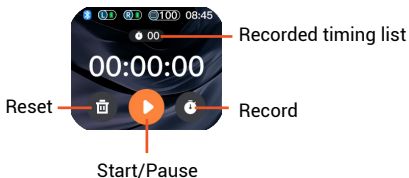


8. "Like" App

When you watch a video on a video app, such as TikTok, and you like it, you can open the Like App, and tap the heart icon to engage with the content on the app. Tap the </> button to switch onscreen viewing pages.

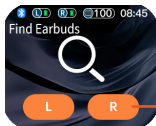


11. Flashlight



Repeatedly tap on the screen to switch among white, red, yellow and green flashlight.

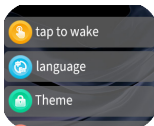
12. Find your earbuds



Tap to send the alert to your earbuds. Your earbud will play a ringtone to alert you of its location.

13. Settings

Open the Settings app to adjust a wide variety of the earbuds and touchscreen case's settings, including language, wake operation, sound, restore to factory settings and more.



Troubleshooting

| Problem | Solution |
|---|--|
| Your left and right earbuds aren't connected. The LED indicators on both earbuds are alternating between white and blue lights. | First, reset the earbuds by taking out the earbuds from the charging base and then placing them back to check whether they are connected to each other. If they are not, open Bluetooth settings in your device and tap "Forget device" on "CETW645" , then turn off Bluetooth in your device to manually initiate the True Wire stereo connection. Please allow up to 30 seconds to connect if you are in a public area with interfering signals. |
| Your left and right earbuds are connected, but you cannot connect them to your device. | Ensure the earbuds are not currently connected to another device. If they are, open Bluetooth settings on those devices and tap "Forget device" on "CETW645" . Confirm the device you would like to pair with is Bluetooth enabled, please refer to that device's user manual to confirm. |
| There is no response from the CETW645 earbuds. | Firstly, check whether the battery power in earbuds are used up, if they are, charge the earbuds. If they are not, reset the earbuds by taking out the earbuds from the charging base and then placing them back, or tap Settings >Factory on the case touchscreen to restore it to the factory settings. |
| You can only hear sound on one earbud. | Reset the earbuds by taking out the earbuds from the charging base and then placing them back. or tap Settings > Reset on the case touchscreen to restore it to the factory settings. |
