

## WHAT'S INCLUDED



## **INSTALLING BATTERIES (for LED Power)**

Locate and flip open Battery Door.

- 2. Install 3x AA batteries following correct polarity shown in the compartment.
- 3. Close Battery Door until it snaps into place.

## **USING THE LANTERN**

After properly installing batteries, press the Power Button to turn on the LED Lantern light.

1st press: ON/HIGH mode 2nd press: LOW mode

3rd press: Strobe Emergency mode

4th press: OFF

## **BATTERY STORAGE**


To store batteries, slide open latch on Battery Storage compartment door, and open. For best results, place batteries in compartment positive side up. Close and secure door when done.

You can store 23 AA batteries, 17 AAA batteries and (2) 9V batteries.

## **BATTERY TESTER**

Remove Battery Tester from storage compartment.

- 2. Based on battery type/size, place bottom/negative side of battery on tester side marked with "-", and insert top/positive side into corresponding position, as seen in drawings.
- Display will show charge level remaining in battery.
  If level is in yellow or red section, consider disposing
  tested battery and replacing in intended device. If
  display remains blank, battery should be disposed
  and replaced.
