User Manual

Safety Information

Please read and understand this entire manual before attempting to assemble, operate or install the product

- Keep away from open flames or heat.
- Avoid allowing metal or foreign objects (such as dust) into the device's USB charging port or any other slot. If a metal object or other foreign object enters the port. Remove the debris before using the USB port.
- Only authorized service workers can perform service operations on the device.
- DO NOT attempt to disassemble or repair the equipment yourself.
 Failure to do so may result in equipment damage or personal injury.
- DO NOT strike, throw, step on, apply excessive pressure, or subject the device to severe physical shock.
- DO NOT disassemble the device as this may puncture the battery and cause personal injury or damage to the device.
- This product (including accessories) has magnets. Swallowing the
 magnet could cause serious injuries such as choking or intestinal
 damage. If a magnet is accidentally swallowed, seek immediate
 medical attention. Keep this product out of the reach of children and




- 1 Main Umbrella x 1 2 Solar Panel x 1

- 8 Remote Control x 1 9 Remote Control Base x 1


Recommended Base (Base Is Not Included)

- Umbrella pole diameter is 1.5 inches, fitting most bases.
- For a 9-foot umbrella, It suggested use a 90-pound base.
- For an 11-foot umbrella, It suggested use a 120-pound base.
- · Larger base surface areas offer better stability.

Symbol Indicators




Turn on the Power on the Control Board



- 1. Locate the control board on top of the umbrella
- 2. Open the silicone cover on the top of the Control Board. Turn the power switch on the right side in the red box from "off" to "on".
- 3. Push the silicone plug back into place.


Connect the Wind Sensor to the Control Board



Connect the wind sensor to the top of the control board. Both the wind sensor and the control board are magnetic. Once aligned, they will automatically snap together due to the magnetic force.


Assembly

Installing the LED Light




Thread the LED through the center pole following the diagram provided and align it with the corresponding section on the hub. It will automatically snap into place due to the magnetic connection.

Attach The Pole to A Base



- 1. Put the bottom pole in to a base.
- 2. Screw and lock the bottom pole to the base. (Umbrella bases may vary.) *Please make sure to set the base on a flat surface.


Assemble Upper Pole to Bottom Pole



Hold down the button at the end of the upper pole and insert it into the lower pole. Line up the button with the hole and snap into place.

Remote Control


How to Use Remote Control




Press the "Open" button to open the umbrella
Press the "Close" button to close the umbrella
Press the "LED Light" button to Turn on, off, or dim the LED light

Pairing Your Remote



The remote control by default should already be paired with your umbrella.



1. Open the silicone plug on the top of the Control Board. Turn the power switch to on.

NOTE: If the switch is already turned on, please turn it off and then back on. The umbrella will be in pairing mode for 10 seconds after turning the switch to on.

- 2. Press and hold the UP button "▲" on the remote control until the control board beeps.
- 3. This will indicate that the remote has successfully paired with the control board.
- 4. Gently press the silicone cover back into place.

Pairing Your Remote Control to Multiple Umbrellas

To pair multiple umbrellas, you will need to pair each control board individually with a remote and turn off the power after each pairing. When all have been paired you can turn all the umbrellas on. One remote control can pair with multiple umbrellas, but each umbrella can only pair with one remote control. If you pair a new remote control with an umbrella, the previous remote will be automatically unpaired.


- 1. Select a remote that you would like to pair all the umbrellas with.
- 2. Open the silicone cover on the top of each Control Board. Turn the power switches to on.

NOTE: If the switch is already turned on, please turn it off and then back on. The umbrella will be in pairing mode for 10 seconds after turning the switch to on.

- 3. Press and hold the Open button "▲" on the remote control until the control boards beep.
- 4. This will indicate that the remote has successfully paired with the control boards.
- 5. Turn off the power before pairing the next umbrella.
- 6. After pairing all the umbrellas, turn the power for all umbrellas to on and gently press the silicon covers back into place.

Replacing Remote Battery

A CR2032 3 Volt Lithium Coin Cell Battery x 1 (Included in the remote)



- 1. Remove the screw from the cover of the remote control.
- 2. Open the remote control shell.
- 3. Turn the board over to access the battery, then slide the battery out from right to left, as shown in the image.
- 4. Replace with a new battery making sure the positive sign (+) is facing up, and put the screws and covers back in place.


How to Charge the Umbrella

Our smart umbrella has two charging options available: solar or the USB-C charging ports




With the solar panel and control board installed, put the umbrella in direct sunlight. It takes about 12 hours to fully charge depending on the sunlight intensity.

NOTE: The solar panel and control board must both be fully connected as the solar panel will charge the battery in the control board.



Charge using the USB-C charging port on the LED light or control board and connect the other end to a power outlet. It may take up to 3 hours to fully charge.

NOTE: You may remove the control board to charge indoors for your convenience.





At the top inside the umbrella, there are four remaining battery indicator lights. They are activated each time the remote control is used to display the current battery level.

Low Battery Alert


When the battery level is less than 15%, the control board will beep 4 times twice every 30 minutes and you will not be able to operate the LED or LED light bars. When this occurs, charge the control board using the solar panel or via the micro-USB charging ports on the control board or LED Light.

When the umbrella cannot be closed due to a dead battery or for any other reason, you can use the emergency release latch to close the umbrella. However, you must attach the latch back on to open the umbrella.





- 1. On the rope between the upper hub and lower hub of the umbrella, there is a latch. Open the cover of the latch.
- 2. Pull out the end of the upper rope.



- 1. Remove the end of the rib from the pocket cover from the canopy. Then, remove the cover on the rib.
- 2. Press down and hold the connecting part of the LED bar light.
- 3. Pull out the rib light.
- 4. Insert the new rib light. Hold down the latch and connect the LED light bar to the rib. Put the cover back on the rib and slip the rib back into the pocket on the canopy.

Open the cover at the top of the control board. Look for the symbol at the top of the control board. The switches below will indicate the level the wind sensitivity is on. 8 MPH (default), 12 MPH, 16MPH. Follow the diagram above to adjust to your preferred wind sensitivity. When the wind reaches the wind speed you've set, the umbrella will automatically close. Once finished put the silicon cover back on.

We strongly recommend closing and securing the umbrella immediately when encountering high wind speeds or sudden extreme weather conditions to reduce the risk of damage to the umbrella, furniture, and property.
