#### 1. Consult a Physician Before Use If You Have Any of the Following Conditions:


- Use of a medical electronic device embedded in the body (e.g., pacemaker).

# PRODUCT USAGE & MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Keep the product dry. Do not let water enter or splash onto it.
- 2. Avoid using the product in humid environments like bathrooms, showers, or pools, as water and electricity can be dangerous.
- 3. Before plugging in, make sure the product's voltage matches the power supply voltage.
- 4. Do not use the product if the plug, power cord, or the product itself is damaged.
- 5. To prevent electric shock, never attempt to open the product's outer cover.
- This product is not suitable for individuals with physical or mental impairments (including children) unless supervised by a responsible adult.
- If the product is damaged, do not attempt repairs. All repairs must be done by Prospera-authorized technicians to maintain the warranty.
- 8. Children must be supervised around the product to ensure it is not used as a toy.
- If the product makes unusual sounds or noise, immediately turn it off, unplug it, and contact a Prospera-authorized service technician.

A. MODE


"AUTO" Mode : A Combination of Kneading and Air Massage for Feet

"MASSAGE" Mode: Kneading Massage for Soles "AIR" Mode: Full Air Massage for Feet

B. INTENSITY levels

C. HEAT Therapy

D. STOP



## HOW TO OPERATE THE DL002

- Press auto mode button to turn device on default program, which has a combined kneading and air press massage.
- 2. Press auto one more time to shift to deep tissue kneading massage mode.
- 3. Press auto 3rd time to switch to air press massage. Use intensity button to choose low or high intensity.
- 4. Press heat button for heating feature.
- 5. Once you finish, press stop to complete the massage session.

#### The key functions are as follows:

No.	Button	Function
1.	MODE	Press to turn ON with default "AUTO" mode of low intensity Press again to turn on "MASSAGE" mode Press once more to turn on "AIR" mode Press again to stop all massages
2.	STOP	Press to stop the massage any time
3.	INTENSITY	2 Levels of intensity: HIGH / LOW (Applicable to "AUTO" and "AIR" modes only)
4.	HEAT	Heat therapy of the soles

Auto Timer: 15 minutes. Power will turn Off automatically after 15 minutes to prevent over heating.

Always unplug the AC power cord after use.

Problem	Possible Cause	Suggestion
	The product is not plugged in properly.	Ensure the voltage on the product corresponds to the local mains voltage and then plug in again.
The product does	The product has just finished its auto timer session and has automatically switched to standby mode.	If you want another session, press the MODE button again.
The product does not work	You may have used the product continuously for 30 minutes or more where the over heat protection has been activated.	Unplug the product and let it cool down for 60 minutes before you use it again.
	An excessive load has been applied on the product.	Reduce the excessive load and start again.
The product is abnormally warm	The product is likely to be overused.	Unplug the product and let it cool down before using it again.
Noise can be heard from the product	Noise is made by the mechanical parts of the product.	This is normal and does not mean that the product is faulty.

# CARE & MAINTENANCE

#### **Cleaning Instructions:**

Do not use: Steel wool, abrasive cleaning agents, or corrosive liquids.

#### Steps:

- 1.Unplug the product from the power outlet.
- 2.Use a dry cloth to wipe and clean.
- 3. Avoid using damp cloths or detergent.

#### Storage Instructions:

#### Steps:

- 1. Unplug the product from the power outlet.
- 2. Store it in a cool, dry place away from sunlight.
- 3. Ensure no heavy objects are placed on top of the product.
