



### **Using the Hologram Speaker**


- Power on the hologram fan using the button on the **back** of the device.
- Power on the hologram speaker using the buttons on the **top** of the device
- After the speaker is powered on, look for the device A8 in your Bluetooth settings
- Pair the hologram speaker to begin playing music from your paired device
- ☑ Volume can be adjusted using the buttons on the top of the hologram speaker, or by using the volume setting on your paired device
- When battery is low, turn off the speaker and fan, plug device into a wall outlet using the USB-C port on back to charge.
- ☑ The hologram fan will continuously loop the holograms in the playlist
- ☑ The 4 lights on the bottom of the device indicate how much charge is left.
- The fan lubricating oil may harden after prolonged periods of inactivity. If the fan lights up but does not spin, rock the device side to side to get it moving.

#### **Speaker Buttons:**

- 1. Power On/Off
- 2. Volume Down / Previous Track
- 3. Play / Pause
- 4. Volume Up / Next Track
- 5. Adjust LED mode

### **Using the Hologram Fan**

- ☑ The hologram fan can be powered on/off independently, using the button on the back of the device
- The Hologram Fan will continuously loop the preloaded holograms in the playlist
- We recommend turning the hologram fan off occasionally to improve its working lifespan
- The fan lubricating oil may harden after prolonged periods of inactivity. If the fan lights up but does not spin, rock the device side to side to get it moving.
- The hologram fan LEDs will not work well in direct sunlight. Recommended settings are indoors, nighttime or heavily shaded environments

## **Charging the Hologram Speaker**

- ☑ The 4 lights on the bottom of the device indicate how much charge is left.
- ☑ The hologram speaker can run wirelessly for several hours.
- ☑ The speaker may play for a few hours longer than the hologram fan
- If the Bluetooth speaker or the hologram fan runs out of power, charge the device using the USB-C port in the back of the device
- ☑ For the best charging, turn both the speaker and the hologram fan off

#### **Tips & Contact Information:**

- The fan lubricating oil may harden after prolonged periods of inactivity. If the fan lights up but does not spin, rock the device side to side to get it moving.
- The hologram fan LEDs will not work well in direct sunlight. Recommended settings are indoors, nighttime or heavily shaded environments.
- We recommend turning the hologram fan off occasionally to improve its working lifespan.
- Be careful not to drop this device or get it wet, it is an electronic device and not waterproof.
- If the hologram fan or bluetooth speaker run out of power, we recommend turning both the fan and speaker off, then charging the device for several hours.
- If the hologram speaker is not showing up on your bluetooth settings, try turning the hologram speaker on/off, then try toggling the bluetooth settings on your pairable device on/off.
