#### **CLEANING/STORAGE**

- To avoid scratching the lenses and damaging your monocular follow steps below. 1. Blow away any dust or debris on the lens (or use a soft lens brush).
- 2. To remove dirt, grease or fingerprints, clean with a microfiber cloth, rubbing
- in a circular motion. Use of a coarse cloth may scratch the lens surface and eventually cause more damage.
- 3. For a more thorough cleaning, photographic type lens cleaning fluid may be used. Always apply the fluid to the cleaning cloth, never directly on the lens. Do not use any chemicals, abrasives, or solvents. Never attempt to clean your monocular internally or try to take it apart.
- 4. Adapter should be cleaned with soft, damp cloth only. Do not use any chemicals, abrasives, or solvents.
- 5. Store monocular and adapter in dry area at room temperature.
